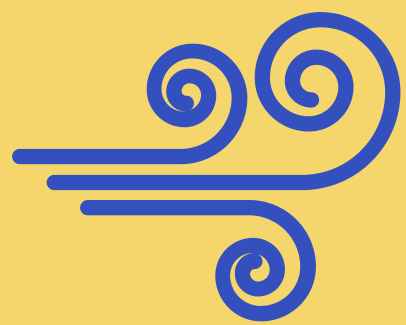


Winter Time Heating Costs

MONEY SAVING TIPS



TURN DOWN THE WATER HEATER

Reducing the water temperature can save up to 11% in water heating costs.



REPLACE FURNACE FILTER

Clogged material makes your furnace work harder, raising energy costs.



MAINTAIN DOORS & WINDOWS

Replace weather stripping and adjust thresholds so no cold air gets inside.



TURN DOWN YOUR THERMOSTAT

Reducing temperature to 68 degrees will save about 5% on room heating costs.



CLOSE UNUSED VENTS

Rooms that don't get used can be sealed off to redirect heat to occupied areas.



TURN ON THE CEILING FAN

Run fan clockwise to push warm air collected near the ceiling back into the room.



CHECK THE ATTIC

Make sure the attic is properly insulated to keep warm air contained in the house.



TURN THE BATHROOM FAN OFF

Humid air will migrate to other areas warming the air in the process.



USE AN ELECTRIC BLANKET

Using low energy, electric blankets will allow you to turn down the thermostat without getting cold.



LIGHT A CANDLE

If the flame gets pulled in one direction there is likely an air leak that can be treated.



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
