# TURN DOWN THE WATER HEATER

Reducing the water temperature can save up to 11% in water heating costs.



#### REPLACE FURNACE FILTER

Clogged material makes your furnace work harder, raising energy costs.

#### MAINTAIN DOORS & WINDOWS

Replace weather stripping and adjust thresholds so no cold air gets inside.



# TURN DOWN YOUR THERMOSTAT

Reducing temperature to 68 degrees will save about 5% on room heating costs.

#### CLOSE UNUSED VENTS

Rooms that don't get used can be sealed off to redirect heat to occupied areas.



#### TURN ON THE CEILING FAN

Run fan clockwise to push warm air collected near the ceiling back into the room.

#### CHECK THE ATTIC

Make sure the attic is properly insulated to keep warm air contained in the house.



#### TURN THE BATHROOM FAN OFF

Humid air will migrate to other areas warming the air in the process.

#### USE AN ELECTRIC BLANKET

Using low energy, electric blankets will allow you to turn down the thermostat without getting cold.



#### LIGHT A CANDLE

If the flame gets pulled in one direction there is likely an air leak that can be treated.
